Stewarding of Masses

We desperately need at least 2 stewards for every Mass. Without these, we cannot open the Church for Mass at all. If you arrive at Church a bit early, and you are able to stand by the door and ensure people are wearing masks upon entry, and also if you can give the Church a quick once over with the antibac sprays available, then please do. It always seems to be the same people who apply to help but in reality we should all be doing our bit. If you notice nobody standing at the front of the Church when you arrive, by all means put your coat down to reserve your space in the Church, but then please do come back to the entrance and help us out. Thank you.

Baptisms

Based on the current official guidance, Baptisms cannot take place any earlier than May 17th, unless there is risk of death. On May 17th, Baptisms are planned to resume and 30 people should be able to attend. All pre bookings will be based upon the updates from the government being happy with the process and roadmap. If you would like a Baptismal registration form, please email the parish office and you will be sent one and contacted in due course.

Planned Giving Offertory Envelopes

Envelopes MUST be collected from the Parish office. This is so we do not leave boxes with people's personal information lying around in the Church. Please do come during the office hours. Thank you.

Standing Orders /Gift Aid

Should you wish to start a standing order rather than collect your envelopes, or if you do not have a payment method in place, please take a form from the back of the Church. This form also has a gift-aid declaration (and is the only acceptable Gift Aid Form now) if you are able to. Thank you.
