This is a great opportunity to meet you in a relaxed atmosphere and to introduce you to some parishioners who are actively working in the parish.

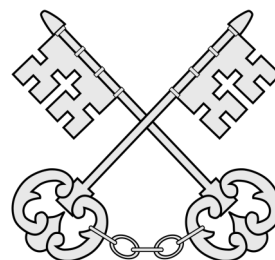
Could I ask all the groups in the parish to ensure that you are represented at this event by a couple of members.
