To name a horse is £5, to sponsor and name a race is £30, perfect for any business owners that want some cheap advertising!

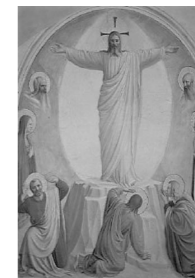

Last week I attended a beautiful Mass at St Rose's Convent, just next to Gladstone Park. I'm sure that some of you know this oasis of prayer in North West London. As I looked around the marquee where the Mass was being celebrated by Cardinal Nichols I could see lots of familiar faces from many and varied places. It was good to see parishioners from both The Transfiguration and St Mary Magdalen's, and also to see friends from other parishes and from schools like St Dominic's V1th Form College. This reminded me that as well as the life the parish, there is much that goes on beyond it. Yes, of course, the parish is the most basic element of many of our lives: it is where we are baptised, receive the sacraments, maybe are married and where we come week by week to gather as the local community to celebrate Mass, but we are part of a much wider community than that, with our Cardinal Archbishop at its centre. And he is our tangible sign of Communion with the Pope.

Your priests, for example, are incardinated into the Diocese of Westminster. That means that we have taken a promise of obedience to our bishop, and he can appoint us to parishes and ministries wherever he sees the need arise. The Cardinal appointed Fr Allan to the parish of Willesden Green, and then to the parish of Kensal Rise. Lots of us in both parishes, and at Newman Catholic College, have much to say 'thank you' to Father Allan for. His enthusiasm and humour, his spirituality and his knowledge have enriched us all, and I must record my personal thanks to him. We pray for him as he takes up his new appointment, at the Cardinal's request, to the parish of Kentish Town.

In these days of fewer priests, we must be very grateful that the Cardinal has appointed Fr Matteo di Giuseppe to our parishes. I very much look forward to working with him as a colleague, and I know that you will hold him in your prayers.

At every Mass we pray for our Pope and also for our Bishop. This reminds us that we are part of the Catholic Church. It is a daily reminder of the importance of staying connected as a universal Church in communion with believers across the world and down the centuries. May our sense of Communion grow ever stronger within our parishes and beyond to the diocese and the wider Church.
