If you are a Brent resident, 38 years and above, and would like a first dose of the Pfizer vaccine, please call 03000339950 between 9am and 4pm to book an appointment. Anyone who has had a first Pfizer vaccine at least 9 weeks ago can also book their 2nd vaccine on the same phone number between the same hours. You will need to present your NHS number and date of birth.
