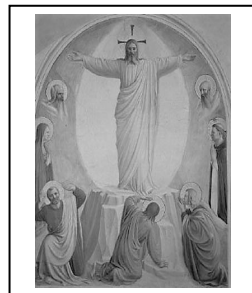

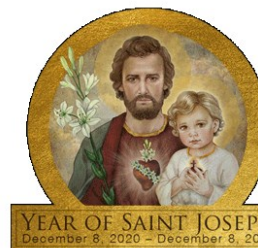

Motivation for Mark 10:35-45:

"I invite you to think for a minute about your baptism. Perhaps it happened when you were a baby and you have no memory of that moment of being received into the Christian family; or maybe you are only just beginning the journey towards baptism, and it is for the moment only a thought or a stirring in your heart. In this moment of Lectio, I invite you to dwell, spiritually, at the baptismal font, the gateway to communion with Christ and his entry into your heart. Not only does our life become his life, but his life becomes our life. In this Word of the Gospel, Christ makes himself known to us. What part of you, or your life, is he reaching to today? How does he bring the light to illuminate your darkness?"
