If you are a **Brent** resident, 20 years and above and would like a first dose of the Pfizer vaccine, please call 03000 339950 between **9am and 4pm** to book an appointment. Anyone who had a first Pfizer vaccine at least 9 weeks ago can also book their 2nd vaccine on the same phone number between the same hours. You will need to present your NHS number and date of birth.

Stewarding of Masses & Church Open Outside of Mass

We now only need Stewards for our Sunday Masses, as these are the Masses most likely to have an overflow of Parishioners wanting to attend. The Church can also now be left open during the day for people to come for private prayer without stewards as long as people check in via the NHS Track and Trace app, using the QR code in the Church or by signing in on the sheet.
