This Parish is part of Westminster Roman Catholic Diocesan Trust (WRCDT) Registered Charity No: 233699 It is now five years since the Cardinal appointed me as Parish Priest of Willesden Green and two years since he appointed me as Parish Priest of Kensal Rise. The last two years have seen both parishes really emerging from the shadow of Covid, and the Mass counts carried out in October show that people are returning to Mass. I am so pleased to see new faces almost every week in both communities, and to hear the children in church.

All over the diocese parishes, while maintaining their independence, are working in partnership. You may be aware of the pairings of Harrow Road and Bayswater, of Archway and Tollington Park, of Mill Hill and Burnt Oak, and most recently St John's Wood and Marylebone. In our own parishes, Fr Allan and I, as priests appointed to both parishes, share the pastoral care between the two communities. The sacramental programmes are shared between the parishes – the First Communion at St Mary Magdalen's Primary School and the Confirmation at Kensal Rise. I am very grateful to the families and catechists who enable this to happen. We also have been advertising social events in both parish newsletters so that we can get to know one another and give a strong Catholic witness to our neighbourhoods. I am thinking, for example, of the Summer Fair and The Christmas Dinner at Kensal Rise and of Fr Francis' First Mass and the coronation celebrations at Willesden Green.

Throughout the Diocese, parishes are developing growing relationships with each other, and are finding some new ways of thinking and working with changing resources and fewer priests. In our own parishes, where there were once three priests there are now two.

I am very grateful to all who have been helping this development to happen. The fruit of your work is two flourishing parishes. I look forward to seeing more growth in the future.
