### Thank You Fr Natalino!

### School Application Forms

School forms have now been issued and Catholic schools require a Certificate of Catholic Practice. These can be obtained by calling the Parish Office by booking a time slot to get the certificates signed. A certificate confirms that you have been known to us for a minimum of 5 years and that you attend Mass every Sunday. If you require a certificate and have not been in the Parish for 5 years, you will need to contact your previous Parish to obtain a letter stating that they have known you for the time period before you joined our Parish. Only then can we also write a letter confirming we have known you since you have been here. If we have no record of you in the Parish, either through our register of parishioners, planned giving or standing order contributions, we will find it difficult to confirm your presence within the Parish. Please do not turn up without an appointment. Appointments are 15mins long so please be on time. We have opened our diary for this coming Tuesday and Wednesday.

### Holy Communion Photos

Those who ordered photos of the First Holy Communion can now collect these at the Parish Office during opening hours. Payment can also be made in the office but cash only. Bank transfers can also be made but please bring proof of payment when collecting.

Applications for first holy communion and confirmation are now available to collect from Fr Sean after Mass. Please also take a Mass Register sheet from the back of the church. This will need to be signed weekly by the priest celebrating Sunday Mass.

### The Mass Intentions diary for 2019 is now full. The diary for 2020 is now available.

Please note that Masses are booked on a first come first serve basis. Only one intention is booked per Mass which is Canon Law. We cannot move or change Masses that people have booked in to accommodate for others wanting the same date. Mass stipends must be paid for at the time of booking. If you want a specific Mass date, please come into the office instead of writing on the Mass Intention envelopes to guarantee / seek alternative dates.

### Volunteer to be a Catechist

We are very fortunate to have two wonderful catechists at present and with an extra pair of hands it would help immensely to share the load.
