I am sad to announce my departure from Kensal Rise. I have been Parish Priest here for 18 years and I can honestly say that they have been very happy years, the happiest in my priesthood. I came to the Parish at the age of 38, still somewhat naïve, but you soon knocked me into shape. Over half my priesthood has been spent here and I leave with a heavy heart. I will never forget all the support, love and friendship I have received from you all, especially when my mother died. You will always be in my heart and I will pray for you. Please pray for me. On September 1st, I take up my new position as Parish Priest of both Corpus Christi Tring, and The Sacred Heart Berkhamsted. I hope to live in the Presbytery in Tring, which is a beautiful market town in Hertfordshire. As you can imagine it is going to be a very different appointment, so please continue to pray for me. My head is all over the place at the moment as I contemplate trying to pack and clear the clutter of 18 years. I have not been informed who will be replacing me at Kensal Rise but who ever he is, he is a very lucky man, for I know you will support him as you supported me. One thing I do ask, and that is you remember “he is not me.” He will come with new ideas, new ways of doing things, and please God will bring fresh life and enthusiasm into the life of the Parish. On arriving in a new Parish it is always difficult, so please have patience and be open and responsive to his guidance, ideas and a fresh beginning. As soon as I have news on who he is I will let you know. It will be sad not to have seen so many of you who have not returned to Mass since the outbreak of the pandemic. I only have another 9 Sundays left in Kensal Rise and it would be lovely to see you before I go. There are so many individuals I wish to thank but this is not the time to do so. I hope that we will have the opportunity to come together at a later date for a drink and an opportunity to say goodbye.
