If you wish your form to be signed, please make an appointment and do not turn up at the door nor hand it to me after Sunday Mass. The new certificate of Catholic Practice has been issued by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. I can only sign this certificate for children from practising Catholic families, i.e. that you attend Mass here every Sunday. If you only attend occasionally i.e. once a month or once a fortnight, I will only sign the certificate if you can produce a letter from the Parish Priest where you attend on the other Sundays.
