November is the time the Church sets aside every year to pray for the Holy Souls. There will be four Masses said each week during November for the names on our November Dead List. If you would like your deceased loved ones and friends remembered in these Masses, please put their names in a November Dead List envelope and return it to the church or the Presbytery.
