### Update On Fr Sean

Last Saturday I had an operation to remove a growth on my vocal cords which all went well. I was informed that the consultant felt that I may have to return in about 6 weeks time for a further operation which would mean removing an area of flesh around the growth and depending on results, a possible course of radiotherapy. He felt the growth that was removed was "on the turn" or at a very early stage of cancer but he also told me that the biopsy results could prove him wrong. I am still waiting for these results to come through and I ask you to keep me in your prayers. I will resume my ministry on Monday 4th February after having been told to rest my voice.
