Although there had been a slight change in the cells of the growth, it is nothing to worry about at the moment and the hospital would like to monitor me by giving me regular endoscopies. Thank you for all your prayers and cards. I will be resuming normal duties on Monday, this weekend I am away at a family celebration. God bless you, Fr Sean.

St Francis Leprosy Guild Collection

We have chosen to hold an appeal and second collection for The St Francis Leprosy Guild, who were founded by a group of Catholics in 1895 to fight leprosy, and are launching a campaign in the UK to increase support for the early detection and treatment of leprosy as part of the World Health Organisation's strategy to achieve a leprosy-free world. The aim is to reinvigorate efforts to control leprosy and avert disabilities, especially among children still affected by the disease in endemic countries such as Brazil, Indonesia and India. Leprosy has become one of the neglected tropical diseases continuing to maim and disable people and yet is tantalising so close to eradication.

Leprosy can be completely cured through multi drug therapy lasting a number of months and has been eradicated in many parts of the world. But it is still endemic in many remote areas. Last year WHO reported at least 200,000 new cases – and these are only those reported. Kieran Kettleton, Director of the Guild will speak about the campaign to eradicate leprosy at Masses on 9th and 10th February.
