My dear Parishioners, Christ is Risen, Alleluia!

Once again, we have followed in the footsteps of Christ over the last few days and experienced through the liturgy, his Passion and death. This was beautifully expressed through our Solemn Liturgies and sacred music.

On Holy Thursday, we remembered our Lord instituting that foremost Sacrament, the Holy Eucharist, the Sacrifice of the Mass. And with that, the ordained priesthood, so as to perpetuate the mystery of the cross throughout time.

On Good Friday, we walked with our Lord as he carried his cross, a cross weighed down by the sins of the world, my sins and your sins. I find it a truly moving experience as I watch you, my dear friends, come forward to kiss the wounded feet of Christ. Some of you I know carry in your heart the loss of a loved one, terminal illness, breakdown in a relationship, or your own personal crosses. This morning we gather to continue that celebration, the resurrection of our Saviour Jesus Christ. Today let us truly rejoice and celebrate the depth of God's love for us in his son, Jesus Christ.
