Id like to thank everybody who signed up for direct debit last weekend and for those who requested planned giving boxes. Your continuing generosity and support is greatly appreciated. Can I remind you that if you are a tax payer, please do ensure you sign a gift aid form. This means for every pound you contribute to the Parish, we receive 25p back from the government, but only if we can prove you have signed a gift aid form. These can be obtained from one of the helpers at the back of the church.

Last Sunday, I emphasised how much easier the financial administration of the Parish is if people use direct debit forms. It means that we do not have to buy the planned giving envelopes which cost us a considerable amount, it means we do not have count the money week after week, it means we do not then have to record each individual envelope on a database and we do not need to keep hold of every individual envelope for 6 years (for tax purposes).

By using direct debit it means that the Parish continues to receive a regular income throughout the year especially if you are away for long periods in the summer holidays, school half terms, Christmas, Easter or for a long weekend. Using this form ensures the financial stability of the Parish.

Can I ask you please not to help yourself to a box of envelopes, but speak to one of the designated volunteers.
