LENTEN ALMS PROJECT

Tyburn Convent is home to a Benedictine Community of Contemplative Nuns. It is the Mother House of the worldwide Congregation of the Adorers of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, dedicated to Perpetual Adoration of the Holy Eucharist and prayer for the Holy Father, the

Church and the entire world. The Congregation has in recent years responded to the call of three Popes to the New Evangelisation, and with the help of God and the support of their benefactors have begun establishing new monasteries in Latin America, Oceania, Europe and Africa. This work is ongoing and costly, with purchases unfinished, building repairs to be done and regulations to be met, visa and travel expenses to be paid, in addition to the daily running costs of 12 monasteries. The Mission Foundations are already bearing great fruit, as the local communities have enthusiastically welcomed the opportunities to deepen their life of prayer and spirituality by participating in the prayer life of the Sisters. They have also been consoled and encouraged by the presence of those willing to listen to their needs and concerns and pray for them. Situated in the heart of London, Tyburn Convent also houses the National Shrine dedicated to the Tyburn Martyrs who were executed nearby on the Tyburn Gallows during the English Reformation. The arrival of the French Foundress

also facilitate night vigils of prayer. They welcome guests seeking a few days of quiet, and also Local, National and International groups to the shrine. There is now an urgent need to improve the conditions of the areas where guests and visitors are welcomed, particularly the facilities for groups, and the lay night Adorers. Throughout the year schools, confirmation groups, RCIA groups, Pilgrimage groups and many others are able make use of these facilities, and hence they are now worn out and in disrepair. The sisters would greatly appreciate any help you can give to their fundraising efforts at this time and also invite you to their Monastic Afternoons which are held from 2-5pm at Tyburn Convent on the first Sunday of every month.

PILGRIMAGE TO ROME FOR THE HOLY YEAR OF MERCY

Fr Kevin Jordan, from St Mary Magdalens, and myself will be leading a pilgrimage to Rome for the Holy Year from 26th - 29th of September. We will begin the pilgrimage once we have reached Rome by entering the Holy Door of St Peter's Basilica then celebrating Mass in the church dedicated to the Divine Mercy and Sr. Faustina. It will be a packed itinerary which will enable us to see as much of Rome as possible including visits to the Basilicas of St Mary Major, St John Lateran and St Paul's outside the walls. The Basilica of San Clemente, parts of it dating back to the 1st century, a general audience with His Holiness the Pope, Piazza Navona, Pantheon, Trevi Fountain, the Catacombs of San Callistus, an evening stroll around the Colosseum and much more.

The price will be £595 per person in a twin/double room or £650 per person in a single room (limited availability). Included in the price are transfers to and from the airport, flights, hotel accommodation, full board - 3 dinners, 2 lunches, wine with your meals, excursions and entry charges. It does not include travel insurance, 2 lunches, while we are out sightseeing, and obviously personal expenditure.

Rome is a city built on seven hills and best seen on foot, so a reasonable level of fitness is required. We will only be taking 15 members of each parish, so it will be first come first served. A deposit of £300 per person made payable to *Anthony R Coles Travel and Conferences* and a completed booking form will ensure your place. These must be given to Fr Sean or put through the Presbytery letter box.

It will be a wonderful experience to visit the glories and beauties of Rome especially during this Holy Year of Mercy. Please remember there is limited availability. You will find the booking form and complete itinerary at the back of the church. Please only take these if you are seriously interested in coming. Any questions please speak to Fr Sean.

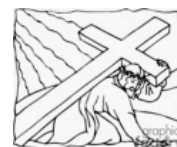
