Fees (i) There is an administration fee apart from the church fee of £40. (Cheques made payable to Church of the Transfiguration) (ii) If the marriage is taking place outside of the parish the paperwork has to go to the diocese and they charge a £40 handling fee (cheques made payable to Diocese of Westminster)

Church Fees: A question often asked is 'how much does the church charge for marriages?' This is a difficult question to answer as financial circumstances are different for every couple. Some couples are spending large amounts of money on clothing, flowers, receptions, honeymoons etc. Other couples cannot afford such expenditure. Some London churches are asking for **10%** of the total cost of the wedding for the church, however we do not demand this. In this church we have a two-tier system. If you attend this church on a Sunday, we are asking for **£300**, as you already contribute to the Sunday collection. If you do not attend Mass here on a Sunday, we ask for **£500**, as you are using the building for the convenience of your wedding only. However, parishioners and non-parishioners may decide to give more depending on your circumstances. These fees do not include the Registrar's fee which is **£50**, organist **£100** or flowers and the services of the flower ladies if you wish to use them. Cheques for the church fee should be made payable to The Church of the Transfiguration, the other fees are cash only. They all need to be paid before the wedding and by the wedding rehearsal.
