REJOICE!

How do you picture Jesus Christ? I am sure that in every one of your homes there is at least one crucifix, and that is the best known Christian sign. But there is more to Jesus Christ than his last few hours of agony on the Cross. Our gospel today shows Jesus as a normal young man – he would have been around thirty years old when he went to the wedding at Cana in Galilee. He went to parties and he enjoyed himself. Weddings were no quiet affair in the first century AD. They involved the whole community, there was much food and drink, they lasted for maybe a week. I do not think that Jesus sat to one side of this celebration looking 'holy'. I am sure he joined in the music and the dancing.

It is here, where people are having fun, being themselves, rejoicing in love, that the fourth gospel tells us that the first sign or miracle was performed by Jesus. This must tell us that God is at the heart of all human life – he is not just there for the crisis moments, for illness or sadness or bereavements. God is at the heart of all our rejoicing. This weekend our sacramental programmes get under way – First Holy Communion and Confirmation. God is present in these times of rejoicing, when families get together on The Great Day and have fun.

Religion is not just serious business – of course doing good, learning some theology, being disciplined about coming to Mass on Sundays and saying our daily prayers are all important. But the heart of our faith is love – and love expresses itself in celebration just as much as it does, for example, sacrifice.

I hope that you will all find things to celebrate this year – weddings, maybe, sacraments, maybe – birthdays almost certainly. Remember that Jesus Christ is with you just as much as you laugh and have fun as in more serious times.
