WHAT DO YOU THINK?

'What do you think?' 'Your views are important to us' 'Your voice moves Uber forward'. We are for ever being asked to send feedback, via our computer or iPhone. Everyone, it seems, wants to know what we think, what our opinion is. Hospitals ask you about it – even prisons ask inmates before they kevae what their experience was like (probably not Danilel Khaliffe, though). You can then fill in an on line questionnaire, but it can be quite frustrating. Last week, I cancelled an Uber booking quite simply because it was taking too long, and I went by tube instead. This resulted in a survey from Uber asking all sorts of questions, but all I wanted to tell them was it took too long. That was my opinion.

I think a lot of this depends on who is asking the question. If it's some AI programme, that's one thing. If it's Jesus Christ, it's quite another. The gospel today begins with a question from Jesus. He is testing the chief priests and the elders of the people – what do they think. A man has two sons. He asks the first to go and work in the vineyard, and like sons the world over, the boy says no he won't. But then he changes his mind. The other son is full of respect for his father – 'Certainly, Sir'. But then he finds something more interesting to do.

What do you think? There is something of both sons in us, if we are honest with ourselves. There are times when we know what we ought to do, but don't do it immediately, but then think and maybe pray, and our hearts turn to God. There will also, sadly, be times when we respectfully say Yes, but life gets too complex and distracting and we do not do what have promised.

What do you think? Are your actions aligned with you words? Let us try to give a genuine and wholehearted response to God's call, so that our actions can speak more loudly than our words.
