One year ago, on Advent Sunday 2021, Cardinal Nichols appointed Fr Allan and myself to the Parish of the Transfiguration, Kensal Rise. The parish had been through an unsettled time, with the departure of Fr Sean after 18 years and with all the fall out of the Covid crisis still hanging over the parish. Covid meant the numbers at the Sunday Masses were quite small; the weekday Mass timetable had been cut right back; the various committees of the parish were not very active.

Fr Allan and I came to a beautiful church, where, even with all the current challenges, the Mass, the heart of parish life, was offered beautifully and prayerfully. The choir had returned, the servers and readers were on the sanctuary and the organ enhanced the 10am Mass. The administration of the parish was in Chelsea's capable hands. The sacristans were ensuring that everything for the altar was cleaned, polished and pressed. The children were growing in their faith through their own liturgy.

In my first few weeks as your parish priest, I was made very welcome, and so many of you assured me of your prayers. You were generous in your acceptance of a new structure for the parish, sharing your clergy with St Mary Magdalen, Willesden Green.

Your prayers (and mine) have been answered! The children and young people of the parish have been prepared for the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation, with catechists taking an active part in this formation. The Finance Committee has welcomed new members and is actively overseeing the finances and the fabric of both church and house. Fr Allan has taken up residence in the Presbytery, and, among other blessings, this has meant the church can be open once more during the day. Numbers at all the Masses have increased, and young families with children have been warmly welcomed. One year later we are restoring an extra Sunday Mass to cope with the numbers. The Social Committee has been busy, and there is much to look forward to.

I would like to thank each and every one of you for all that you are doing. I would like especially to thank Fr Allan for his ministry among us.
