MARY IN MAY.

It is always wonderful when the Solemnity of Pentecost comes in the month of May. Pentecost in May enables us to focus our prayer on Our Blessed Lady and her openness to the work of the Holy Spirit in her life. Through this openness, Jesus Christ was born; through this openness, the Church came into being; through this openness, we are able to turn in prayer to the Mother of God.

I recently went to a most beautiful exhibition at the Victoria and Albert Museum. It is called 'Donatello Sculpting the Renaissance.' Donatello expressed his deep faith in sculpture, and there are many inspiring works by this artist in the exhibition. For me, the most moving piece is the one you can see in the photograph above. It is called 'The Pazzi Madonna' and was carved around 1410. It drew my attention and moved my heart because of the natural intimacy it shows between mother and child – just look at how their faces are almost joined as they gaze into each other's eyes. This is the intense and unique relationship between a mother and her baby. This is the Mother we call on to pray for us to her Son – no wonder he hears her prayers.

In Luke's gospel we read the words of the angel Gabriel to Mary: 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will cover you with its shadow' Mary opened her heart to the Holy Spirit, and Jesus Christ was born. As we strive to open our hearts to the Holy Spirit, may the love of Jesus Christ be made known through us.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death.
