'Can I have a Rosemary?'

'Can you I have a Rosemary, Father?' This was a question I was asked time and again at Feltham Young Offenders. I ended up having to keep a register of the boys who had been given them, to make sure they did not ask too often.

I knew that for some of them, the little plastic rosaries I gave out were maybe little more that prison bling. The could wear them and feel a bit better. But giving them a rosary was always an opportunity to teach them about praying, for them to learn off by heart the rosary prayers, and know the intercession of Mary for them. Yes, they sometimes took advantage of my good nature, but I didn't mind.

When I met Pope Francis in 2013 he gave me 100 rosaries which he blessed to take back for the boys. They became very special to them – they were astonished that the Pope should be interested in them. The Pope knows the importance of the Rosary for us all, as he said at an audience in October 2020:

'I invite everyone to rediscover, especially during this month of October, the beauty of the prayer of the rosary, which has nourished the faith of the Christian people through the centuries. I invite you to pray the rosary, and to carry it in your hands or in your pockets. The recitation of the rosary is the most beautiful prayer we can offer to the Virgin Mary; it is a contemplation on the stages of the life of Jesus the Saviour with his Mother Mary and is a weapon that protects us from evils and temptations.'

Our gospel today speaks of thanksgiving. Maybe find time every day in October to offer a decade of the rosary for a blessing which you have received.
