Changes to Mass Times during Lent

There will be 2 Masses on Ash Wednesday at 10am & 7pm. Every Friday during Lent there will be Mass at 12noon followed by the Lenten Lunch in the Newman Room. There will be no Holy Hour on a Friday during Lent, instead Stations of the Cross at 6:15pm followed by 7pm Mass.

Can I remind everyone that Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent are days of fasting and abstinence, this means that no meat in any form can be consumed.

Lenten Alms - The Pembridge Hospice

We increase our devotional life by trying to spend more time in prayer, we fast on Fridays in Lent, and we give alms/money to those less fortunate.
