Holy Souls—November Dead List

November is the time the Church sets aside every year to pray for the Holy Souls. I find this month a time of great consolation for it reminds us that our love and relationships with our family and friends does not end with death; as members of the Church that relationship continues and in fact we can help the souls of our loved ones through the offering of the Sacrifice of the Mass. There will be four Masses said each week during November for the names on our November Dead List. If you would like your deceased loved ones and friends remembered in these Masses, please put their names in a November Dead List envelope and return it to the church or the Presbytery.

School Applications and the Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP).

The diocese has issued a new certificate for those applying for a place at Catholic Schools. This has simplified the process and made the life of Parish Priests much easier, as they no longer have to fill in lengthy school forms. However, the diocese has also made it very clear who can receive the CCP. Firstly, the Parish clergy can only sign forms of those who have been attending Mass in the Parish for the last five years. If a family have been attending Mass for less than 5 years, they will need to supply a letter from their previous Parish stating they practised their faith. Only then can the CCP be signed. By the term 'practising Catholic', the diocese has confirmed Church teaching that a practising Catholic is someone who attends Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation.
