Urgent Appeal

In late October the Parish is being audited by the Diocese to ensure that all our financial affairs are in order. This creates an enormous amount of work for Chelsea as she gets all the financial documents, etc, in order for the auditors. One thing that had to be done was compiling a list of contributors for both Planned Giving and Standing Orders. I was a bit taken back with the number of individuals and families who kindly contribute but have not signed a Gift Aid form. This means that we are losing out on an enormous amount of money that the government would give back to us. If everyone who contributed had signed a Gift Aid form, we could have claimed back £26,000! But due to the tiny amount of people who have signed up we only received £2,000 back. This situation must stop! I can't understand why working people have not signed a Gift Aid form as it would benefit the Parish enormously if they did. I will be writing to each individual and families and would ask you to really consider taking 2 minutes of your time to sign one of these forms. I would like to stress that you will pay no more than you already are towards the Parish, the money comes from the government in tax relief as we are a registered charity. Please please do sign the form that I send and return it to the Presbytery. The Gift Aid forms CAN be backdated so if you would like to help us claim more from last year, please date 6th April 2016.
