Dear Parishioners,

As I mentioned two weeks ago, and as I mentioned several months ago at the Sunday 5pm Mass, it has been on my mind that we have too many Masses for the number in our congregation. Kensal Rise has changed quite dramatically over the last decade or so, the social make up is now very different to what it was when I moved to the Parish 14 years ago. Whole communities who once made up the majority of this Parish are no longer here, as house prices have increased people have sold up and moved away, and as rents have gone up, numerous families have come to say goodbye to me as they are no longer able to afford the large rent increases. Our last Mass count was 560. That number of parishioners can easily be accommodated at the Saturday 6pm, and the Sunday 9 and 11am Mass. There is also a Mass in Italian at 12.30. We do not live in a rural area and there are parishes very close by which will continue to have a Sunday evening Mass. For instance, St Mary Magdalen's which is over twice the size of this Parish, has a 6:30pm Mass on Sunday. I did ask for some feedback on my thoughts and I heard from two parishioners saying its lovely to have such a choice of Masses and how important the offering of Mass is. However, we need to look not at what is convenient, but what is practical, and we need to be thinking of the future. Therefore, the last Sunday evening Mass will be on Sunday 31st December. I am so grateful to the large positive response to this necessary change and to the support of the Parish Council.
