Mary's Meals will be coming to our church in a couple of weeks' time to take away your unwanted clothing and bedding (no duvets or pillows please). Over the next few weeks please collect your unwanted clothes and put them in tied sacks. Then before 11am on Sunday 2nd February bring them with you when you come to Mass. Not only will you be getting rid of unwanted clothes/bedding and giving yourself a little more space but you will also benefit a really worthwhile charity. Mary's Meals feeds children one good meal every day at school in over 18 countries. Because of our low costs we can do this for as little as £13.90 per child per year!

OUTSIDE THE CITY - Thursday 6th February 18:30

The monks of Leicestershire's Mount St Bernard Abbey are an aging community of 25 men who have turned their backs on consumer society to focus on spirituality. Although mindfulness of God and fraternal communion are the rules of the order, they must still evolve in order to preserve their ages-old way of life. Currently the order is changing from dairy farming to brewing as they aim to produce the first UK-brewed Trappist beer. The stakes are high - if their historic counter-cultural lifestyle is to survive, this very contemporary venture must succeed.

Director Nick Hamer spent a year with the monks, gaining privileged access to their hidden lives. The doc is beautifully filmed, and the monks also collaborated with a local composer to provide the film's evocative score.

Nick Hamer joins us afterwards for a live Q&A.

In today's secular world, it is so important for us of faith to support ventures like this to keep films on religious subjects being made, shown and watched.

The Lexi has always been open to showing films of a religious nature. Many of you may have gone there to see the beautifully crafted documentary on the Carmelites or Of Gods and Men, the tragedy of the Trappist monks murdered in Algeria and Into the Great Silence, an intimate portrayal of the everyday lives of Carthusian monks of the Grande Chartreuse, a monastery high in the French Alps. Each of these films were well-supported and very enjoyable.

For those of you who don't know, the Lexi donates 100% of its profits to The Sustainability Institute, a pioneering South African charity dedicated to changing lives. Please support this film and continue to support the Lexi. Without the community, the Lexi would struggle to be viable, without the Lexi, the community would not have a first class resource for showing films and hosting many other events, mostly for charity.
